New Rule Changes for 2017 Effective January 7, 2017

Rule VII, Part II, Section 1, Page 29

Every PCHA rated Hunter/Jumper horse show must retain the services of a PCHA steward(s). **Shows** requiring more than 1 (one) steward may request a guest card for stewards that are not members of PCHA. At least 1 (one) steward must be a current PCHA member in good standing. The PCHA steward must be present for the entire show. Guest card fee is \$25 per show.

Rule V, Part I, Section 6, Page 23

Qualification for points:

- A: Horses and ponies must be registered with the PCHA before points will be computed.
- B: Owners, **Riders and Trainers** of the horse or pony must be fully paid members of PCHA before points will count,
- C: If a horse or pony-is sold, points will stop from the time of the sale until the PCHA office receives a \$10 transfer and new information regarding the ownership of the horse or pony in question.

Rule XI, Part XIII, Section 4, Page 61

To qualify for a year end award, **Owner, Trainer, horse and rider** must fulfill the membership and horse registration requirements in Rule I and II. Horse/ Rider must have competed in at least 3 (three) different PCHA shows in the particular division, class or section that they are trying to win for the year end award.
